Course Aim

The aim of the course is to provide your employees with knowledge of basic health and safety practices essential in the workplace, which will enable them to contribute to any health and safety management system.

This includes the hazards and risks along with the relevant legislation and ensures awareness of cost effective, practical control methods.

Who Should Attend

This course is ideal for all employees in the workplace, regardless of the industry they work in.

Everyone is at risk from work-related illness and injury, particularly new staff, employees who have recently changed job roles or taken on extra responsibilities and those who haven't refreshed their skills in the past three years.

This course is not suitable for Managers or Supervisors who already have basic health and safety knowledge. They would need to attend the Level 3 Award in Health and Safety within the Workplace qualification.

Candidates are not required to have any prior knowledge or qualifications in health and safety to enable them to attend this course.

However, it is recommended that candidates have a minimum of Level 1 in Literacy/English or equivalent to undertake this qualification.

Candidates should be aged 14 or above.

- Working ergonomically and workstation design.
- The importance of risk assessment.
- Personal protective equipment.
- The importance of good storage, stacking, maintenance and housekeeping.
- Using equipment safely.
- Fire safety in the workplace.
- Methods and controls to reduce the risk of common workplace hazards.
- Hazards and risks associated with working with vehicles.
- Identifying substances hazardous to health.
- Safe manual handling techniques.
- Potential effects of exposure to noise and vibration in the workplace.

You will understand the responsibilities of employers and employees under health and safety legislation and the importance of undertaking a risk assessment to prevent and control hazards.

Assessment Method

Candidates will be assessed by a multiple choice examination, where the candidate must answer at least 12 out of 20 questions correctly.

The examination will take 45 minutes to complete and successful completion will result in a Highfield Level 2 Award in Health and Safety within the Workplace certificate.

Refresher Recommendation
