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Level 2 Award in Risk Assessment

Course Aim

The aim of the course is to provide your employees with the information required to ensure that they are able to carry out effective risk assessments.

It includes the five stages of the risk assessment process and the risk assessment format to use.

Who Should Attend

This course is right for employees who are involved in developing a risk assessment and/or enforcing procedures in the workplace.

Whatever environment they work in, it will raise their knowledge of risk assessment in the workplace and ensure they know how to implement the necessary controls to ensure that the risks are reduced to a safe level.

This course is not suitable for managers or supervisors who already have basic risk assessment knowledge. They would need to attend the Level 3 Award in Risk Assessment qualification.

Entry Requirements

Although it is not essential, we do recommend candidates have a basic understanding of health and safety prior to attending this course, ideally the Level 2 Award in Health and Safety in the Workplace.

It is also recommended that candidates have a minimum of Level 1 in Literacy/English or equivalent to undertake this qualification. Candidates should be aged 14 or above.

- Employer's duties in relation to risk assessment.
- Main causes of work-related fatalities, injuries and ill health.
- Main costs of work-related accidents and ill-health.
- The role of risk assessment in the prevention of accidents and ill health.
- Understand the principles of risk assessment.
- Requirements for risk assessment.
- The process for undertaking a risk assessment.
- Use of the hierarchy of control.
- How to evaluate the risk.

Assessment Method
