ABOUT THE COURSE

The HSE supports the use of eLearning for first aid refresher training. To be able to give first aid a person must have a practical training qualification. The qualification expires after 3 years. However, 3 years is a very long time to remember all the important details of the training, therefore online refreshers are an excellent way to recap and bridge the gap between practical sessions.

AREAS COVERED

The modules cover the theory elements of the Level 3 First Aid at Work qualification. These modules include:

- Roles and responsibilities of a first aider
- Assessing an incident
- Managing an unresponsive casualty
- Recognising and assisting a choking casualty
- Managing a casualty who is bleeding or in shock
- Managing a casualty who has a minor injury
- Conducting a secondary survey
- Administering first aid to a casualty with injuries including head, bones and spinal injuries, suspected chest injuries, burns or eye injuries, sudden poisoning or anaphylaxis or a suspected major illness.

ASSESSMENT AND CERTIFICATION

Candidates will be assessed by a series of multiple-choice questions upon the completion of each of the modules. Subject to satisfactory completion, candidates are given access to an electronic Highfield quality endorsed certificate of completion (in PDF format), which they are able to print.
