



Combined Level 3 Award in Emergency First
Aid at Work and Paediatric First Aid

Course Fact Sheet

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Course Aim

The aim of this specially designed course is to provide your employees with the skills and knowledge needed to provide both emergency adult and paediatric first aid.

The course allow employees to dual qualify in just one day rather than having to attend two separate one day courses, therefore saving both time and money.

Who Should Attend

This course is perfect for those employees who have a specific responsibility at work to maintain adequate first aid provision for both adults and paediatrics in their care, such as schools, sports clubs or other childcare settings.

Please note that the Early Years Framework states that anyone left in sole charge of a child or children require the two day Paediatric First Aid qualification.

Course Length

One day

Entry Requirements

Candidates are not required to have any prior knowledge or qualifications in first aid to enable them to attend this course.

However, it is recommended that candidates have a minimum of Level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent to undertake this qualification. Candidates should be aged 14 or above.

The Content

- The roles and responsibilities of a first aider.
- How to minimise the risk of infection to yourself and others.
- Accident recording and reporting.
- First aid equipment that you should be available in the workplace.
- The safe use of first aid equipment.
- How to quickly assess an emergency situation.
- How to put an adult, infant or child in the recovery position.
- What to do if adult, infant or child is unconscious.
- How to manage an adult, infant or child who is experiencing a seizure.
- Practical life saving CPR skills using adult and infant and child CPR manikins.
- The actions to take when someone is choking.
- How to deal with external bleeding.
- Recognising the symptoms of shock and what to do.
- How to treat a casualty with cuts, grazes and bruises.
- How to treat a casualty with minor burns and scalds.
- How to treat a casualty with small splinters.

The Benefits

By attending this practical course, your employees will understand their role and responsibilities as a paediatric first aid appointed person in the workplace as well as the legal requirements for first aid provision.

On returning to the workplace, they will have the confidence to react quickly in response to an incident. Administering a good level of first aid quickly can often be the difference between life and death.

You will be able to demonstrate compliance with legislation and prove due diligence through training records and certificates. In addition, you, your business, your employees and your customers will be protected.

Assessment Methods

Assessment is by six practical assessments and activities and a multiple choice examination, where the candidate must answer at least 7 out of 10 questions correctly.

The examination will take 15 minutes to complete and successful completion will result in a Qalsafe Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work certificate and a Qalsafe Level 3 Emergency Paediatric First Aid certificate.
